The MYGAJT is open to boys and girls aged between 6 and 14 years of age. Juniors will play different lengths of holes according to their physical age and will complete either 9 or 18 holes in each event.

Membership

Juniors can join the MYGAJT for a year which includes a new MYGAJT 2011 shirt, preferred entry fee into MYGAJT tournaments and a 10% discount in our golf stores. Juniors can only play one event as a non-tour member (taster event).

New Formats of Play for 2011 season

The MYGAJT has developed a new exciting structure for its tournaments in 2011 with the a unique playing concept for junior golfers which has been designed around their physical age to encourage juniors to record their scores relative to par on a manageable course which is constructed relative to their maximum hitting distance with a driver. This new format of play will mean that competitors will only face holes of distances they can manage physically and will also mean that the correct completing of a scorecard will need to be carried out which educates them from an early age.

Order of Merit (OOM) 2011

The MYGAJT has devised an order of merit system for it members. At the end of the 2011 season the winners of each category will be decided. Awards will be made at the MYGAJT Grand Final at Horne Park Golf Centre. Order of Merit points can only be gained at each event including the final if a competitor is a member of the MYGAJT.

The MYGAJT will consist of 6 events in 2011 all of which are Order of Merit qualifying events. Each competitor will have their highest OOM points taken from their **top 3 events** throughout the season which will accumulate to make their total OOM points for that season. This then caters for a bad round or two which we all experience time to time!

Entering a MYGAJT event

Once you have entered a MYGAJT event, you will receive an email confirming your entry has been received. At this present time players ARE NOT individually notified of tee times. After the closing date, which is usually 7 days prior, all paid entrants will be listed for tee times and displayed on the MYGA website www.mikeyorkegolfacademy.co.uk.

- ✓ It is the responsibility of the player to establish his or her own tee time.
- ✓ All tee times are subject to change and you must check before travelling.

Arriving at the event

Registration opens 1 hour before the first tee time. At the venue look for the MYGAJT registration desk and make yourself known to the Event Secretary.

Once you have signed in, you will receive your scorecard and confirmation of your tee time and groupings.

- ✓ You must then proceed to the first tee 10 minutes prior to your tee time.
- ✓ Late arrival to the tee may result in two stroke penalty or disqualification.
- ✓ The Event starter will announce on the tee each player's name before he or she tees off.
- ✓ It is acceptable to applaud and give a warm welcome to every player.

Presentations

Trophies/ Medals are awarded to the top finishers at each competition. Each presentation will take place after close of play. Smart casual golf attire is acceptable.

The presentation is a worthy part of every event; it allows players and families to socialise and is an excellent opportunity to interact with others. The MYGAJT has a very proud reputation for our friendliness and sociable side, which can often be found lacking in the junior golf world. Therefore ALL players are expected to stay for every presentation.

Cancellations

In the event of any MYGAJT competition being cancelled, all entries fees will be refunded. The MYGAJT always endeavour to run every event advertised. In the event of insufficient numbers, the event may be cancelled, any registered players will be notified by email and voicemail at the earliest possible moment.

Bad Weather

In the event of bad weather, all registered entrants will be notified ASAP by email and voicemail if the event is cancelled.

Withdrawal Policy

MYGAJT members/non members may withdraw themselves by emailing info@mikeyorkegolfacademy.co.uk before the closing date with no charge.

The entry fee becomes payable for all competitions upon the closing date. Once the competition closing date has passed, juniors will not receive any refund of entry fees. To clarify, if a junior withdraws/cancels their own entry before the closing date, the player is not charged. If a junior withdraws/cancels after the closing date, the player will NOT receive a refund.

Competition closing dates are usually 7 days before an event. Should any withdrawal be later than 48 hours prior to the event, no refund will be available!

Pace of Play

It is understandable that the length of play can become increased during competition. However to maximise the level of enjoyment, players must remain focused on the pace of play. Players will be monitored at all competitions and if necessary, an offending group will be penalised.

- ✓ Player/s will receive a warning if they fall one hole behind the group in front.
- ✓ Player/s who fall two or more holes behind will include a 1 shot penalty per hole until time is caught up.

Slow Play

Whilst practice shots and routine is encouraged, this must not be to the detriment of the speed of play. A slow player is one who takes an excess of 45 seconds to play a shot once it is his turn to play and there are no distractions.

Helpful Pace of Play hints

- ✓ Estimate your yardage before it's your turn to play. Don't leave it late.
- ✓ Move on to your next shot without delay.
- ✓ Read your putt before your turn.
- ✓ Be aware of the group in front not the group behind.
- ✓ In the event of a lost ball, a player has 5 minutes. Parents, caddies and spectators can search for a lost ball. If it has not been found after a minute or two, allow your fellow players to play on towards the green while you search.
- ✓ If your ball might be lost outside a water hazard or out of bounds, play a Provisional Ball.
- ✓ Position your bag or trolley to the side of the green which is closest to the next teeing ground.
- ✓ Mark your cards at the next hole whilst players take their tee shots and NOT whilst on the green.

Caddy Policy

On the MYGAJT, a caddy is the person who carries a player's bag. A junior golfer may only have ONE caddy.

One of the most important roles of the caddy is to have a good knowledge of the course being played, which includes knowing which tee the player is starting from, the overall yardage, pin placements (*when available*) and club selection.

For all 18 holes events, using red, yellow or white tees, MYGAJT Caddies are NOT permitted to give advice or assistance on the green. ONE caddy may tend the flag. Caddies also must be sure not to step in any of the imaginary lines between golf balls and the hole.

Some helpful hints for caddies

- ✓ Before the round, ensure the player has sufficient water and food for the duration for the event. British weather is notorious so please be prepared with sunscreen and waterproofs.
- ✓ It is useful for caddies to have knowledge of the course, and such details as where the water hazards and bunkers. The MYGAJT allow SkyCaddy and GPS to assist with distances, in accordance with R & A guidelines.
- ✓ Be ready, have to hand in your caddy bib, spares golf balls, tees and pencil. If a player loses a ball or breaks a tee during the round, the caddy can simply hand the golfer a new ball or tee. This saves time and the hassle of digging through the pockets in golf
- ✓ Caddies should always carry a towel that can be used to keep golf clubs and golf balls clean. Clubs should be wiped after each shot, even if they do not appear dirty, and balls should be wiped before a putt and between holes
- ✓ Caddies should help fellow competitors in spotting and searching for balls.
- ✓ Caddies should replace and repair divots, and rake bunkers.
- ✓ Don't turn the competition into a coaching session, if you feel you know better save it. Juniors will learn by mistakes and during the competition is not the time to address coaching issues.
- ✓ Pace of play is paramount for an enjoyable round. The caddy should prepare the player for the next shot without delay.

Code of Conduct

The MYGAJT aims to run high quality, professional and fun competitions.

We are very proud to be raising the profiles of junior golfers around our area. The etiquette expected on the MYGAJT are just as important as rules, and by enforcing these we are setting the bar for the high standards expected from all who attend our events.

In order to continue making the tour enjoyable for everyone, the MYGAJT expects all parents, spectators and players to accept that by entering our events you agree to abide by the rules and codes of conduct.

Any breach of these rules may cause a ban from attending any MYGAJT event, and any persons guilty of improper conduct at any competition will be asked to leave.

PARENTAL PRESSURE can be well-meant, however it often becomes unwanted pressure on the child. Also, we like to point out that OVER-INVOLVEMENT is a serious issue in many golf tournaments. Parents often become over-involved or protective. In both instances, the child never learns to be responsible. It is also natural for parents to live vicariously through the child, but when the parent's goals and expectations exceed the child's, added pressure is inevitable.

VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT

- ✓ Unsportsmanlike conduct, including abusive language, club throwing, disrespect to volunteers, officials or fellow competitors.
- ✓ Deliberate miss-counting of shots.
- ✓ Any abusive behaviour to any other persons and property.

EXPECTATIONS OF PARENTS / CADDIES

- ✓ To refrain from coaching.
- ✓ The role of the caddie is to support, advise ONCE, on club selection, and shot required. Allow the player to take responsibility for their own golf game. Continually adjusting their stance, grip and line up is coaching.
- ✓ Allow MYGAJT Officials to administer rulings, not spectators. You will be brought into a situation ONLY if the Official asks you;
- ✓ To respect the officials and their authority during the competition, persons will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike behaviour, such as refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures, or applauding opponent's losses.
- ✓ In the event of any unsolved issues with MYGAJT, parents should speak solely to the MYGAJT Officials at an agreed time and not in front of children.
- ✓ When on the course, turn off mobile phones or switch to silent / vibrate mode.
- ✓ All spectators please stay off fairways, tees and greens.
- ✓ No loud talking, No noise making, Walk – never run on the golf course.
- ✓ To praise your child for competing fairly and for trying hard, and never ridicule or yell at a child or others for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- ✓ Applaud for the performance of both your child and other children.

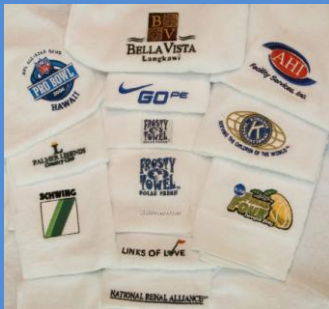
